Jobs4Solidarity is a project within the framework of the **European Solidarity Corps**, a European Union initiative open to the participation of young people between 18 and 30 years old that want make a difference to society. You could have a remunerated full-time job for a whole year in Luxembourg or abroad\*, but there are also opportunities for shorter job placements, starting from three months, if that suits you more.

*\*Your work contract may be extended beyond 12 months, but will no longer receive financial support from the European Commission.*
